**Important points:**

Tick the space beside each requirement before submitting your graduate’s applications. Only send copies of the above documents except for the original Treasury official receipt.

Incomplete application forms will be declined by the PNG Nursing Council.

**Skills log book**

We do not require you to send all skills log books but a summarised report can be listed under student vitae (form G3 and G4). Three copies of the skills logbooks may be randomly selected from each respective school to be screened by the PNG NC. The latter will be used to measure against quality assurance or evaluate training programs taught in each school.

**\*One Character Reference.** A person who has known the individual for at least 2 years. The person cannot be a member of your family or member of educational institute where the graduate trained.

Reference must include:

- referees full name and contact details
- your full name and date of birth
- how long and how the referee has known you
- include statements about your character, reliability and integrity, and what in the referees opinion makes you suitable to be a registered nurse or midwife in PNG
- whether to their knowledge they know of any reason you should not be registered with the PNG NC e.g. any issues of fitness to practice or conviction of an offence.
